The Ordination Ceremony of Bishop Liam MacDaid.

Last Sunday, Monsignor Liam MacDaid, a native of our Parish, was ordained Bishop of Clogher. It was a day enjoyed by representatives of Church and State. Every Parish in the Diocese had parishioners present. Bundoran and Ballyshannon had a generous number of relatives, neighbours and friends present to view the ceremony and take part in the congratulations which followed the occasion. Cardinal Sean Brady, Bishop Joseph Duffy and Bishop Noel Treanor were the main ordaining bishops while approximately one hundred and twenty priests concelebrated the Mass.

We wish Bishop MacDaid every success in the years ahead and guarantee him our support and prayers in his mission of continuing the work of the Lord in the Diocese of Clogher.

We hope that Bishop MacDaid will take the opportunity to visit his home Parish of Bundoran very soon. A date has yet to be agreed but we hope that his homecoming will honour him in every way possible. His visit to Bundoran will include the celebration of Mass and an opportunity to meet and greet the Parishioners. We are given to understand that Bundoran Town Council intend to officially welcome the new Bishop and we hope it will be possible to combine both occasions, on the same day. We will keep everyone informed on preparations, once the date has been agreed.

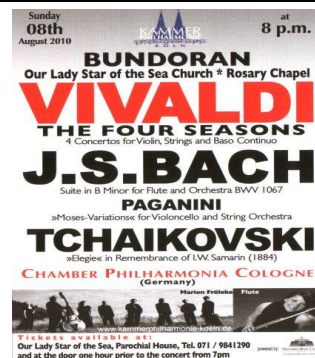
Memorial to those who died in the fire at the Central Hotel August 1970
